

BULK TRASH COLLECTION

Bulk collection will occur at the curb. There is a limit of four cubic yards. Please see description of Bulk Waste below:

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS INCLUDE:

- » Carpeting (cut into 4-foot bundles)
- » Household furniture
- » Appliances with CFCs removed and tagged by a certified technician
- » Moving boxes (broken down and bundled)
- » Oversized waste customary to normal household operations

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS INCLUDE:

- » Appliances containing CFCs
- » Household hazardous waste
- » Gasoline
- » TV'S
- » Paint
- » Batteries and fluorescent light bulbs
- » Tires
- » Vehicles and parts
- » Large pieces of metal

- » Concrete, brick, asphalt, and roofing
- » Motor oil (and used filters)
- » Construction debris
- » Dead animals
- » Syringes

REMEMBER:

- » WM cannot dispose of items containing CFC refrigerant (i.e., refrigerators, freezers, etc.)
- » Household waste is not allowed during BULK COLLECTION.
- » All unacceptable items must be removed and properly disposed of at a landfill or other appropriate facility.

WHAT IS A YARD? HOW DO I MEASURE IT?

The truck collecting the debris will measure for you. The hopper at the back of the truck holds two yards at a time. Four cubic yards equates to WM filling the hopper twice. Residents must remove all acceptable items from public view until the following month's bulk pickup.
