Open Meeting: Call to order: Mayor Saunders called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. This meeting was Facebook live-streamed.

Discussion: Any updates the City Council and Citizens need to be made aware: Robert gave an update on the COVID-19 pandemic, what the City has done and will do to keep the Citizens of Smithville protected.

Discussion and Action on a Resolution for the Declaration of Disaster caused by the COVID-19: Councilwoman Morgan made a motion to approve the Resolution for the Declaration of Disaster. Councilman Gordon Seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

Discussion and Action on a Resolution postponing May 2, 2020, General Election to November 3, 2020: Councilwoman Barrientos made a motion to approve a Resolution postponing May 2, 2020, General Election to November 3, 2020. Councilman Gordon seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

Discussion and Action on Temporary Decision-Making of the City Personnel Policy Manual as a Response to COVID-19: Robert Tamble would like to have temporary authority to make changes to the personnel manual to permanently add two weeks sick time (80 Hours) to all full-time employees account and one week (40 Hours) sick time to all part-time employees account. Councilwoman Morgan made a motion to allow the City Manager to temporary make decisions on the City Personnel Policy Manual as a Response to COVID-19. Councilwoman Barrientos seconded and the motion passed unanimously.
