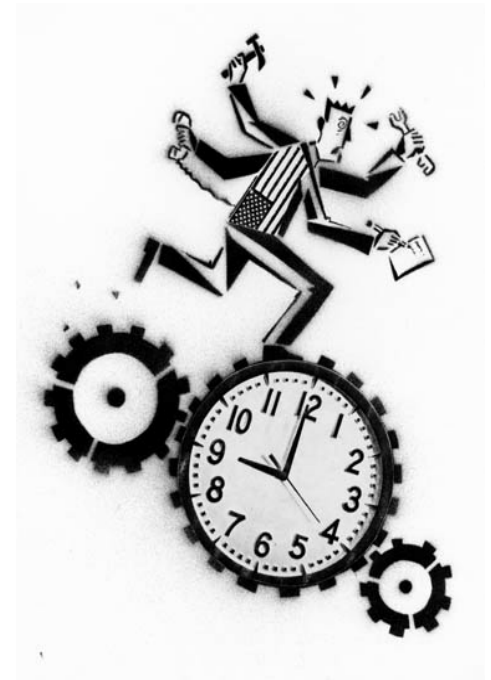

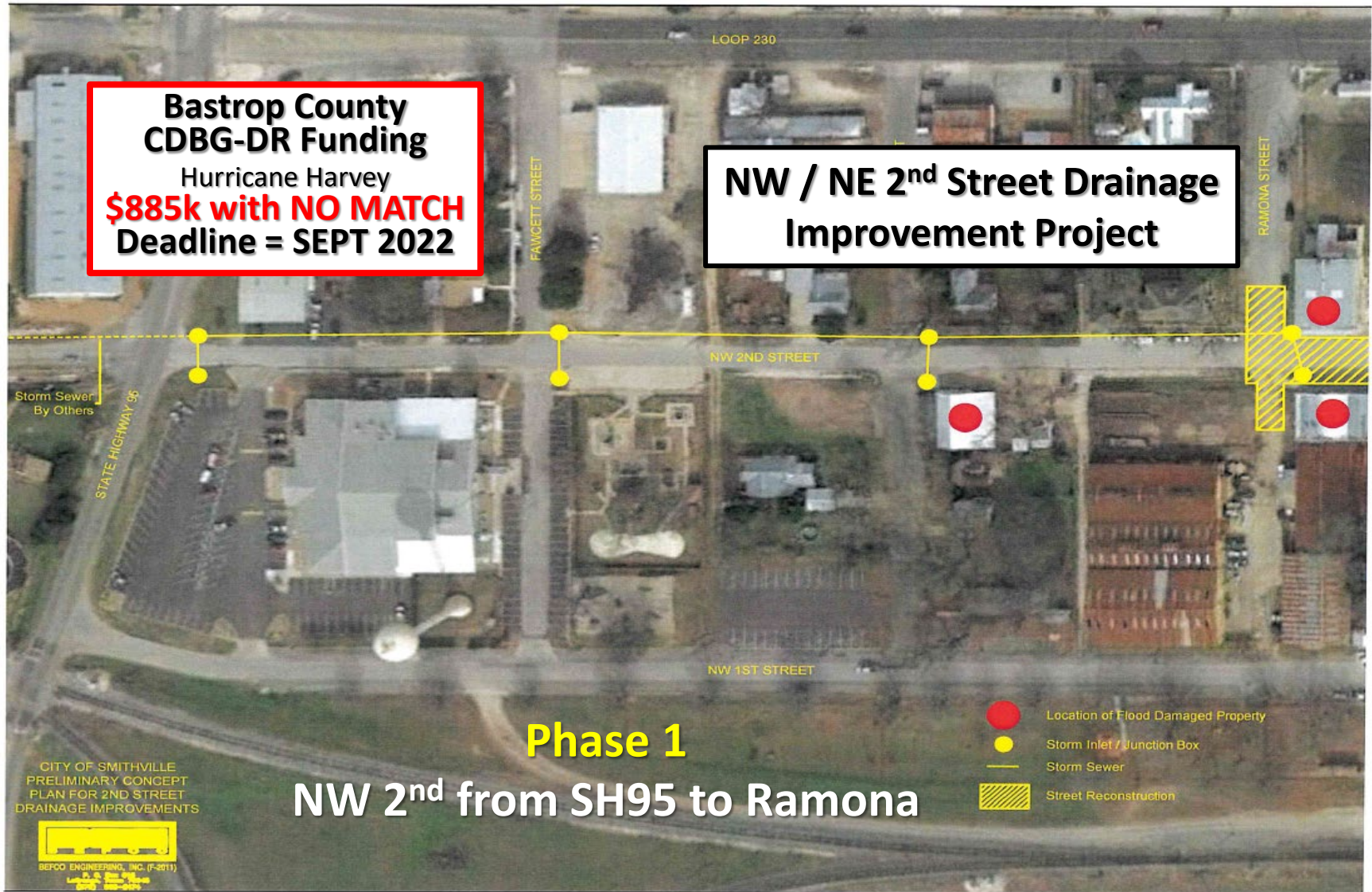

AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT (ARPA)

American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA):

- City of Smithville to receive **\$1,118,752** in funding administered via Texas Department of Emergency Management (TDEM).
- No match requirement. \$559,377 (50%) received 8/19/21.
- 2nd Distribution \$559,375 – August 2022
- Eligible expenses include:
 - COVID-19 Expenses – Testing / Equipment
 - Infrastructure – Water / Sewer / Broadband
 - Tourism, Travel, Hospitality
 - Small Business Assistance
- 1st Round Funding committed to:
 - **Chamber** - \$200k (Workforce Training Center, Tourism)
 - **Smithville Community Clinic** - 100k
 - **City Hall** - \$40k (Council Chambers A/V System)
 - **Local SBA Relief Grants** - \$100-125k (TBD)
 - **WWPT Expansion Feasibility Study** - \$75-100k

ARPA Funding Request

Background:

- 2nd Round Distribution of \$559,375 – August 2022
- Additional funds requested for Tourism and Infrastructure:
 - 4th of July Fireworks Display @ Riverbend Park - \$25k
 - Upgrade A/V system in the Media Room @ Rec Center - \$25k
 - Water Line Extension on Loop 230 West from Solar Farm to Airport - \$250k
 - Gazley Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) improvements / upgrade - \$150k
 - Enhance / expand Broadband @ all City Facilities - \$25k
 - Riverbend Park
 - Recycling Center
 - WWTP
- Must divert funds from Council Chambers A/V system to cover 4th of July Fireworks display.

Sound Ordinance Update / Discussion

Background:

- City Ordinance, Chapter 8 – “Offences and Nuisances”, Article 8.04, Division 2 – Noise.
- Concerns / complaints regarding Outdoor Amplified Sound:
 - Business owners limited to two(2) outdoor amplified sound events in 30-day period.
 - Citizen complaints received that events held in CBD are creating nuisance noise in residential area.
 - Current regulations are difficult to enforce and create unnecessary administrative burden.
- Established City Task Force to review ordinance and meet w/ stakeholders to obtain feedback / input.
- Held Public Forum / City Council Workshop (12/8/21) to solicit feedback from Business Owners and Citizens.
- Benchmarked other municipal sound ordinances.

Sound Ordinance Update

Current Status:

- Sound Ordinance updated with the following RECOMMENDED revisions:
 - Eliminate requirement for outdoor Sound Permit (no limit to the number of amplified events during 30-day period).
 - Re-define acceptable sound levels at Generator's property line (Residential vs. Non-Residential).
 - Re-define Day-Time / Night-time Hours.
