

#### **Budget Summary:**

- Achieved \$1.4M debt reduction in past 2-years.
- 2016 Contingency Expenditures running \$300k.
- Mild winter/summer brought < Utility revenue (<\$450k).</li>
- Payroll expense lower due to 29% attrition (<\$250k).</li>
- <u>Property Tax</u> value / <u>Sales Tax</u> revenue significantly higher.
- Utility upgrade producing expected savings (\$115k/6-mos)
- Proposed budget includes 3% merit for salaried employees
  - + \$1.00 base increase for hourly employees.
- Several infrastructure improvement projects pending/underway.
- Multiple **Grant** applications require "earmarked" funding source.
- 2016/17 **PROPOSED** Tax Rate = \$0.565987 (\$0.01255 increase)
- Improved communications b/n City staff, council, and community.
- City is better positioned for growth but still much to do.



#### By the Numbers:

- 61 Full-time EE's / 14 Part-time EE's in 22 Departments.
- 3817 Population / 1,325 acres in City Limit / 10 Parks.
- **2,637 Work Orders** submitted w/ 93% closure rate.
- 235 Fire Department call-outs during FY16.
- 104 Close Patrols supported by Smithville PD
- 339 Arrests, 689 Citations, 1505 Warnings issued by SPD.
- 206 citizen concerns / issues resolved.
- 179,430,000 gallons of water pumped / purchased.
- 150,197,253 gallons of water billed 16% loss
- 42,569,226 kwh / year purchased from LCRA.
- 35,808,400 kwh / year billed 15% loss
