

IMPACT Program: COVID-19 Procedures

As of 9/1/2020

To better run our IMPACT Program, we have listed the current procedures we have implemented so far for the 2020/21 school year. These are ever changing so we may have frequent updates we will provide for you. While this can change up our schedule throughout the year, we will do our very best to keep things as normal as possible for our young participants.

Our goal is to keep everyone safe and healthy so we can continue to provide our IMPACT Program services to you. Once you have read through our current procedures, please sign at the bottom signifying you and your child(ren) will follow our guidelines.

- All participants and staff will be required to wear a face mask during the program
 - Acceptation to this is during physical activity time (gym time)
- Temperature checks of staff and participants will be taken each day at check in time
- Hand sanitizer will be used often throughout the day
- Spaced seating during homework/seated activities
 - We will seat children 6 feet apart during homework and craft time
- Fewer contact games during gym time
 - We will have more games available that allow for social distancing however, not all our games will allow for this.
 - If you wish for your child(ren) to not participate in any games that may require contact, please let our staff know and we will find an alternative game for them to play
- Each participant will have their own supplies (not sharing)
 - We will supply each child with a pencil box that will contain most of the daily items needed.
 - If there is a specialty item we use for craft time, we will have all items sanitized before and after use.
- Sanitize room/items often
 - Rooms will be sanitized after each day.
 - Toys and other used items will be sanitized as well
 - Any books used will go into a container after each use for a 3 days period before put back on the shelf.
 - We encourage the use of personal library books
- Adjustment of schedule and/or rooms to accommodate any protocol changes.
 - We will use rooms to accommodate the needed spacing. This may change frequently. Please check with front desk staff when checking out your child for them to be called out.
- Limited room entry:
 - When you check out your child(ren), the front desk staff member will radio the counselor for them to be sent out to the lobby.
 - We ask that the rooms used by the Program has limited access for sanitizing purposes
- Any child(ren) experiencing any symptoms of COVID will not be allowed to attend the program for the following 72 hours or until they are no longer showing symptoms.
 - A negative test result may also be required.
